SIMILARITIES	DIFFERENCES'
They have scales.	The lizard is smaller than the snake.
Their heads are almost the same size and shape.	The lizard has legs, but the snake does not.
Their eyes are the same.	
They have a long and thin tongue.

Materials:

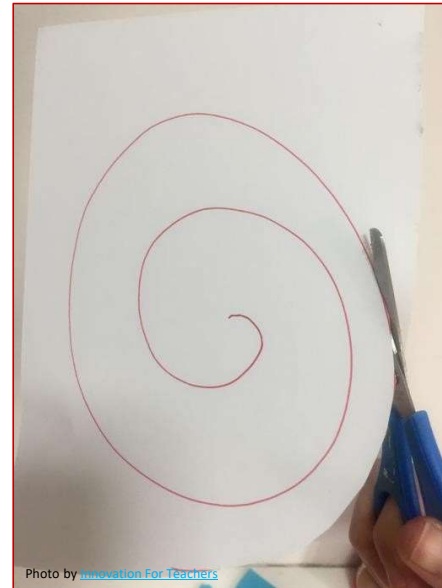
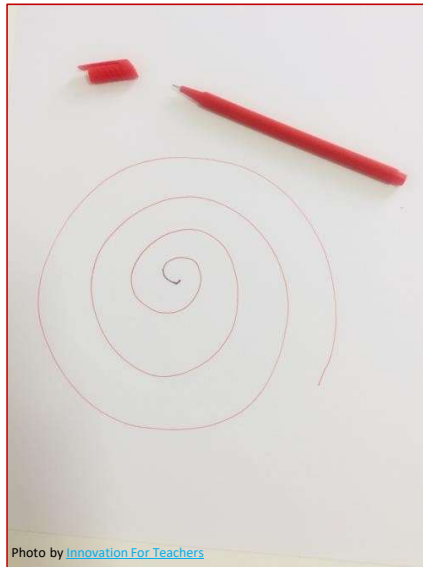
- one colour marker
- Paper A4
- Pisces from old coloured cardboard
- Glue
- one straw
- Twine or rope
- Scissors
- Tape

- Draw a spiral on an A4 paper and cut with your scissors.

- Cut the pieces of cardboard into small pieces.

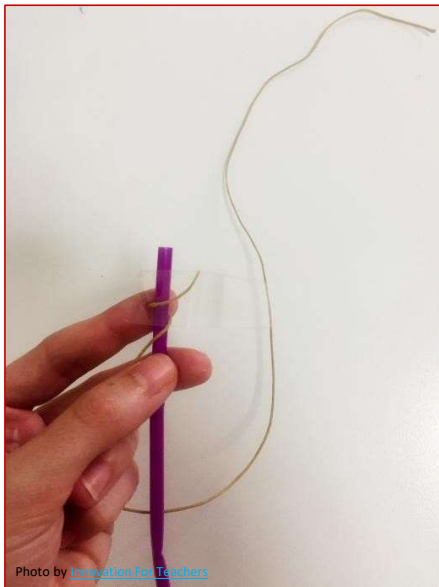
